ARMOUR REACHES FINAL.

Will Play N. A. Dempsey for Shennecosset Golf Title Today.

NEW LONDON, Conn., Aug. 19.—Tommy Armour of Scotland and N. A. Dempsey of Macon, Ga., will meet in the final for the Shennecosset amateur golf title tomorrow. It is the match that the golf enthusiasts here have been looking for. Both earned their way to the final today, but Dempsey had a close call at the hands of Harold Lake, the Hartford star, who is captain of the Harvard team. Lake was one up at the sixteenth, but Dempsey won two holes and then secured a half on the last hole by a brilliant recovery from a sand trap near the green.

Armour had no trouble in getting the decision over C. A. Griscom of Philadelphia by the one-sided margin of 8 and 7. He was out in 35 and then followed this up with two pars and clinched the match. It was the best golf that he has played here, and the experts pronounce him fit enough to make a showing that will be hard to stop at the Engineers Club. Armour's long driving was again in evidence and was very useful when he backed it up with perfect iron plays.
