BREAKS COURSE RECORD.

**G.H. Nichols Sets Mark of 67 for
Shennecossett Golf Links.**

EASTERN POINT, Conn., July 29.—
G.H. Nichols of Providence, who will meet
Alex Herd and J. R. Taylor, the two
English golfers, in an exhibition match
on the Shennecossett links here tomor-
row with Alex Smith as a partner, broke
the course record today by two strokes,
registering a 67. This remarkable score
on the difficult par 72 course was made
with a 35 out and 32 in, the home route
being four strokes under par. The bird-
ies were on Nichols's card, the ninth
hole alone being one stroke above par.
Alex Smith, playing with Nichols, tied
his own record and was only two strokes
behind with a 69.
