## HAGEN AND KIRKWOOD TIED.

Smith. Paired With Stait. Evens  
Shennecossett Record of 67.

NEW LONDON, Conn., Aug. 19.—Walter Hagen and Joe Kirkwood played thirty-six holes all even with Alex Smith, the home professional, and Jack Stait of Hartford, on the Shennecossett links here today. The sensation of the match was the golf exhibited by Smith, twice American open champion. This morning he tied the course record of 67 made by Gil Nicholls. Hagen and Kirkwood each had 69 this morning.

A strong wind made scoring more difficult this afternoon. Hagen and Kirkwood took a lead at the fourth hole and maintained a command of one or two holes all the way to the fifteenth, where Stait's long putt dropped for a birdie 2 to tie the match. On the next hole Smith sank a short mashie shot for a win.

Hagen and Kirkwood went to the eighteenth one down, but Hagen sank a beautiful putt for a birdie 3, which evened the match.
