GROTON, Conn.. July 27.—Max Marston, giant golfer of Philadelphia, won a leg on the new Shene-cossett Country Club trophy by virtue of a well-earned 2-and-1 victory over Howard A. Tryon, youthful golfer of Elmira, N. Y., in the 36-hole final in the annual men's invitation tournament at Eastern Point today.

Both players fought hard over the long course, the Elmira boy giving the Quaker City golfer a hard battle. Both showed excellent handling of the irons and gave the large gallery opportunity for applause time and again. Marston won the Shene-cossett trophy outright last year by reason of three tournament victories. This year he replaced it with another cup. cup.

The first eighteen holes were played in the morning. Marston went out in 37 and came back in 39 for a 76, while Tryon went out in 38 and came in 39 for a 77 total.

The Philadelphian won the first, seventh, twelfth and thirteenth holes and the Elmira player took the fourth, fourteenth and fifteenth. Marston came out of the first eighteen 1 up, and he had to his credit an eagle on the 446-yard seventh.

Marston won the match in thirty-five holes, 2 and 1, but the final hole was played. In the last eighteen holes this afternoon Marston shot a par 72. He won the fourth, fifth, ninth, twelfth and eighteenth holes, while Tryon took the thirteenth, fifteenth and sixteenth holes, shooting a birdie 2 on the fifteenth.

When Tryon failed to win the thirty-fifth hole, halving it in 5, the match was actually over, but they played the final hole. Marston covered the thirty-six holes in 148, Tryon taking 151 strokes.
