GRISWOLD TROPHY WON BY MRS. HURD

Victor Returns Golf Cup to
 Competition After Beating
 Miss Brooks, 4 and 3.

 EASTERN POINT, Conn., July 14.—Mrs. Dorothy Campbell Hurd, veteran Philadelphia golfer, won permanent possession of the Griswold Trophy today by defeating Miss Jane Brooks of Sparkill, N. Y., 4 and 3, in the final of the fifteenth annual women's invitation tournament of the Shenecossett Country Club.

The match, witnessed by a large gallery, ended spectacularly with a beautiful 25-foot putt for a birdie 2 on the 125-yard fifteenth.

Mrs. Hurd, after receiving the cup, turned it back to the Griswold Hotel management with the request that in the future five victories be required for permanent possession.

The medal play of neither finalist was up to the usual standard, Mrs. Hurd going out in 44 and her opponent in 47. The Philadelphia star, who formerly held the United States and British women's championships, was 2 up at the turn.

Mistakes on the outgoing nine were responsible for the rather high medal totals for that stretch. Mrs. Hurd, in attempting to recover from bunkers, twice overshot the greens, while the Rockland Club representative had two topped drives.

The match was even at the end of the seventh hole, and victories on the eighth and ninth gave Mrs. Hurd a margin which she never relinquished.

The ninth hole probably provided the turning point of the duel. Miss Brooks outdrove her rival by 25 yards and both had good seconds. The New York girl, however, overdrove the green on her third while Mrs. Hurd was on safely in 3.

Miss Brooks recovered nicely on her fourth, sending the ball a few feet from the pin, but she missed the short one to take a 6, losing the hole to Mrs. Hurd's 5.
